We've identified eight states where the typical salary for a Forensic Scientist job is above the national average. Topping the list is Massachusetts, with Alaska and Nevada close behind in second and third. Nevada beats the national average by 7.3%, and Massachusetts furthers that trend with another \$8,973 (14.6%) above the \$61,422.

How Much Does a Forensic Nurse Earn? The salaries offered for forensic nursing jobs in the various states in the US vary widely. In a reported survey in 2016, the median salary for a forensic nurse was \$39/hour, or \$81,800/year. The bottom 10% of nurses made around \$50,000/year compared to \$140 000 for the top 10%.
